LADY MONARCH MOMENTS:

- Old Dominion closes out a the non-conference portion of its schedule on Friday against Mississippi. The Lady Monarchs enter the game with a 5-4 non-conference record and looking to snap a two-game losing streak.

- It has been 12 days since the Lady Monarchs were last in action, dropping a 74-65 contest to #15/16 Maryland back on December 21st at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Senior Tiffany Green and junior Jessica Canady both performed double-doubles. Green collected 20 points and 11 boards for her third double-double of the 2008-09 season. Canady poured in 10 points and 10 boards in her third double-double of the season.

- The Lady Monarchs and Lady Rebels have not met since the two teams faced each other in the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament back in 1989. Ole Miss ended ODU's dancing with a 74-58 victory.

- Friday's contest will be the fourth meeting between ODU and Ole Miss. Three of the four meetings have occurred in Oxford.

- Following Friday's contest with the Lady Rebels, the Lady Monarchs begin the "new" season hosting Virginia Commonwealth in the Colonial Athletic Association opener in a rematch of last year's CAA Championship game on Monday, January 5th.

ABOUT OLE MISS:

Mississippi enters Friday's contest with a 10-4 overall mark, winners in three of their last four games. The Lady Rebels, who return four starters and six letterwinners from last year's 13-16 squad, opened the year rattling off seven straight wins. Texas, who defeated the Lady Monarchs in the third game of the season, 78-44, snapped the win-streak with a 74-50 victory in Oxford. The Lady Rebels are led by senior center junior guard Shawn Goff at 14.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game. Bianca Thomas checks in as the Lady Rebels second leading scorer at 12.3 points per contest.

ALL-TIME SERIES WITH OLE MISS:

Friday will mark the fourth meeting between the Lady Monarchs and Lady Rebels with Old Dominion leading the all-time series, 2-1. The two squads have not met since the Lady Rebels stopped ODU's NCAA Tournament run in 1989 in the second round with a 74-58 victory in Oxford.

ODU VS. THE SEC:

NON-CONFERENCE COMES TO A CLOSE:

Old Dominion has one more non-conference game left on its slate in its road trip to Ole Miss. The Lady Monarchs are currently 5-4 in non-conference action going 3-2 at home, 0-2, on the road, and 2-0 in neutral site action. The Lady Monarch's last win on the road (in a non-neutral court setting) was last season with a 80-65 victory in Nashville over #20/21 Vanderbilt on December 30th, 2007.

NON-CONFERENCE ENDS AT THE TED:

The Lady Monarchs closed out non-conference action at the Constant Center with a 74-65 setback to #15/16 Maryland in their last outing back on December 21st. Old Dominion finished the 2008-09 season at 3-2 in non-conference action at the Ted Constant Convocation Center with wins over #16/11 Virginia, Norfolk State, and Saint Joseph's, and losses to #11/13 Tennessee and #15/16 Maryland.

LOSSES IN-A-ROW:

Old Dominion fell in back-to-back games (#11/13 Tennessee and #15/16 Maryland) for the first time since dropping contests to top-ranked UConn (86-43) and #4 and national runner-up Stanford (69-61) during the Paradise Jam last Thanksgiving in St. Thomas. Old Dominion dropped back-to-back home games for the first time since falling three straight to Florida International (80-76) on December 21st 2005, #5 North Carolina in overtime (88-80) on December 29th, 2005 and top-ranked Tennessee (83-67) on January 2nd, 2006.

HOME COURT STREAK COMES TO AN END:

The Lady Monarchs saw its 29-game homecourt win streak come to a close in the 81-76 loss to #11/13 Tennessee. Old Dominion was tied along with the University of Hartford for the nation's longest active home win streak. The win streak dated back to the Dec. 30, 2006, 72-55, victory over national runner-up Rutgers. ODU's previous last home loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center was also against Tennessee, 59-75, back on Dec. 22, 2006.

FAMILIAR FOE BREAKS HOME STREAK:

Tennessee has broken several of ODU's home court win streaks in the past. In addition to Thursday's 29-game home game win streak snapped, the Lady Vols also halted the Lady Monarch's 64-game home win streak in 1981, 33-game home win streak in 1999, and a 17-game home win streak in 1995.

OH SO CLOSE:

The five-point, 81-76, defeat was the closest loss for the Lady Monarchs in the Lady Vol's current 13-game win streak over Old Dominion. The next closest game was a 10-point, 68-58, setback back on Jan. 2nd, 2005. Old Dominion led as late as 1:57 in the game, holding on to a 71-70 edge. The game saw 12 lead changes and nine ties. Tennessee led by no more than seven in the contest.

CAA WEEKLY AWARDS:

Tiffany Green:

11/17/08 - CAA Co-Player of the Week:

Green helped Old Dominion kick off the 2008-09 season with a pair of wins over St. Mary's and Dayton at the World Vision Classic by averaging 17.0 points and 11.0 rebounds per game. Green led all scorers with 19 points as six different Lady Monarchs scored in ODU's 93-63 season opening victory over St. Mary's. She followed by posting her 18th career double-double in the Lady Monarchs' 70-58 win over Dayton. The 6-2 Chesapeake, Virginia native collected 15 points along with a career-high 16 rebounds. On the week Green, shot 50 percent from the field and last year's CAA leader in shot blockers totaled six rejections.

CAA HOME COURT STREAK:

The Lady Monarchs have won 34 straight home CAA contests dating back to the January 14, 2005, 78-59, victory over Virginia Commonwealth. ODU's last conference loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center was against Delaware, 70-73, on January 9, 2005. Old Dominion holds a 161-2 home CAA mark.

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP:

Sophomore Jasmine Parker earned her first career start against #11/13 Tennessee back on December 18th. The 5-6 second-year Lady Monarch ended the night with 14 points as one of four Lady Monarchs in double figures going 5-of-9 from the field and 4-of-5 from beyond the arc.

ADDING DEPTH:

Sophomore Sierra Little made her first appearance of the 2008-09 season against #11/13 Tennessee. Playing 12 minutes, the sophomore Lady Monarch tied her career-high five five boards against the Lady Vols and added a pair of blocks and three points.

IMPROVING FROM THE STRIPE:

Old Dominion shot over 75 percent from the free throw line for the third time this season in its contest with the Lady Vols. The Lady Monarchs went 19-of-24 from the charity stripe shooting 79.2 percent, their second highest percentage this season. Seniors Jen Nuzzo and Jazzmin Walters each went perfect from the line going 3-of-3 and 2-of-2 respectively.

R-E-J-E-C-T-I-O-N:

Senior Tiffany Green is currently tied for ninth in the nation in blocks per game, averaging 3.0 per contest through the first nine games of the season. Louella Tomlinson of St. Mary's currently leads the nation swatting away 5.6 shot per game. Last season, Green led the CAA in rejections at 1.94 per game. She is currently fourth on the CAA All-Time Blocks Leaders List with 178 career swats.

CAREER NIGHT:

Sophomores Shadasia Green and Jasmine Parker each collected career-highs in the Lady Monarch's outing against Saint Joseph's. Parker led all scorers with a career-high 19 points, while Green posted her first career double-double with a career-high 14 points and career-tying 11 rebounds.

RANK 'EM UP - AP POLL:

Four opponents on the 2008-09 Lady Monarch slate are featured in the poll, including undefeated Texas at No. 4 and defending NCAA champion Tennessee coming in at No. 8. Tennessee enters the week at No. 12 with Maryland at No. 15 and Virginia at No. 16. The Lady Monarchs ranked as high as No. 20 in the poll.

POUR IT ON IN THE PAINT:

The Lady Monarchs scored 56 points in the paint against Norfolk State, two more points than the entire Norfolk State team combined in the 97-54 victory back on November 20th.

CAVALIER KILLER:

Something about playing the Virginia Cavaliers seems to bring out the best in senior guard Jazzmin Walters. Last season, Walters nailed the game-winning three-point shot against the Cavaliers with 4.8 seconds remaining in overtime to send the Lady Monarchs to the "Sweet 16" for the first time since 2002. In the rematch last week, Walters collected a career-high 24 points going 6-of-10 from the field and 11-of-12 from the line to help the Lady Monarchs to 78-70 upset victory over #16/11 Virginia.

PRESEASON AWARDS:

Three Lady Monarchs were named to Preseason All-CAA teams. Senior forward/center Tiffany Green was a First Team selection. A First Team All-CAA pick a season ago, she averaged 11.4 points, 7.6 rebounds, and led the CAA in blocks. Senior guard Jazzmin Walters and junior Jessica Canady were Second Team picks. Walters led the CAA in assists, while Canady averaged 11.0 points as the Lady Monarchs' "sixth woman" and led the league in field goal percentage.

CAA PRESEASON POLL - WE'RE #1:

Old Dominion, which has captured the past 17 Colonial Athletic Association women's basketball titles, was picked to repeat as conference champion in 2008-09 according to a vote of the league's coaches, sports information directors and media. The Lady Monarchs, advanced to the "Sweet 16" and earned a 31-5 overall record last season, were followed in the voting by Virginia Commonwealth, James Madison, Drexel, Towson, UNC-Wilmington, Delaware, Georgia State, Northeastern, William & Mary, Hofstra, and George Mason.

HOME OPENERS:

In home openers, the Lady Monarchs are 29-11 including a 4-3 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion defeated Virginia 78-70 in a rematch of the NCAA Second Round overtime game in their 2008-09 home opener on Nov. 21.

SEASON OPENERS:

The Lady Monarchs are 27-13 in season openers including this year's 93-63 victory over St. Mary's in the opening day of the World Vision Classic in Austin, Texas. The 30-point victory over the Gaels was ODU's largest in a season opener since its 82-26 victory over Towson during the 2001-02 season.

RACKING UP THE WIN COLUMN:

The Old Dominion Lady Monarchs finished last season with a 31-5 overall mark. It was the most wins for the program since the 1996-97 season when the Lady Monarchs captured a 34-2 overall mark and reached the championship game of the NCAA Tournament. Old Dominion has posted six 30+ win seasons in history.

500 AND COUNTING:

Old Dominion head coach Wendy Larry cracked a half-century mark last season. In Old Dominion's 74-51 CAA semifinal victory over fifth-seeded Towson, Larry earned her 500th win at the helm of the Lady Monarch program. To date, Larry has captured a 508-168 mark in her 22nd season as the head coach of the Lady Monarchs. 501 was just as sweet as it gave her and her team its 17th consecutive CAA title. Larry reached her 500th career win last season during the 2006-07 season against Chicago State and has a 557-199 overall mark in 25 seasons as the leader of the Old Dominion, Arizona State, and Virginia Wesleyan programs.

Shaw was within six, 20-14, with 6:37 remaining in the first half, but the Lady Monarchs quickly established a double-digit lead shortly thereafter for good. The veterans continued to shine as senior Tiffany Green added in 13 and Shadasia Green contributed 10 points to go along with Canady's game-high 22 points. The posts helped Old Dominion outscore Shaw, 41-16, in the paint. Assist machines Jen Nuzzo and Jazzmin Walters dished out five assists apiece with Walters also collected five steals. Mairi Buchan led the newcomers with nine points and five boards. Old Dominion was untraditionally outrebounded, 43-38, by the Bears. Canady led the Lady Monarchs with six rebounds.

EXHIBITION RECAP - UNIVERSITY OF D.C.

The Old Dominion women's basketball rolled to a 53-point exhibition win on November 3rd at the Ted Constant Convocation Center with a 79-26 win over the University of D.C. Four Lady Monarchs reached double figures led by Preseason First Team All-CAA selection Tiffany Green with 17 points. Green went 5-of-6 from the floor and 7-of-9 from the stripe. The CAA leader in blocks a year ago also registered five rejections on the evening. The Old Dominion defense held the Firebirds to 20 percent shooting and the bench to just four points. LaQuanda Brandon chipped in eight points to lead the University of D.C. The Lady Monarchs used a 22-4 run, including a string of 13 unanswered points, to take a 24-6 edge with 7:43 remaining in the first half. Old Dominion cruised to a 40-12 halftime lead and ended the second half outscoring the Firebirds, 39-14. Joining Green in double figures were sophomore Jasmine Parker with 16, junior Jessica Canady with 15, and junior Jazzmin Walters adding in 11. Canady, a Preseason Second Team All-CAA selection, went a perfect 5-of-5 from the charity stripe. The two Greens led Old Dominion on the boards as the Lady Monarchs outboarded the University of D.C., 41-29. Tiffany and Shadasia Green hauled in nine rebounds a piece.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 17-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 311-17 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 161-2 record at home and a 150-15 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (6-0), George Mason (43-0), Northeastern (5-0), UNC-Wilmington (36-0), and Towson (12-0).

- With her game-high 19 points, senior Tiffany Green has brought her career scoring total to 1,019. Green needs four more points to move into 25th on the all-time Lady Monarch scoring leaders list surpassing Aubrey Eblin (1995-1999).
- In her first career game as a Lady Monarch, freshman Mairi Buchan nearly registered a double-double. Buchan went 6-of-10 from the floor and 2-of-2 from the line to finish with 15 points as ODU's second leading scorer. She also hauled in nine boards.
- In addition to making her first career start, sophomore Shadasia Green set a new career-high mark in rebounds. Leading the Lady Monarchs, who outboarded the Gaels 57-35, 11 boards, Green reset her former mark of eight set against Delaware State back on Dec. 20, 2007.
- Three of the Lady Monarch freshman played in their first career games. Mairi Buchan played 22 minutes narrowly missing a double-double with 15 points and nine rebounds. NORFOLK, Va. -- Junior Jessica Canady hauled in a career-high 19 rebounds and senior Tiffany Green tied her career mark with 21 points to lead the No. 23/20 Old Dominion women's basketball team to a 97-54 win over Norfolk State Sunday afternoon at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

Old Dominion, who upped their overall mark to 4-2 on the, year began the first of a four-game homestand. The Lady Monarchs will have the next week a half off as they prepare for final exams. Old Dominion put up 56 points in the paint, two more points than the entire Norfolk State roster. The Lady Monarch bench also produced 29 points led by sophomore Jasmine Parker. Parker went 3-of-4 from the floor and a perfect 5-of-5 from the line to score 12 points on the afternoon.

The Spartans had just one in double figures. Whitney Long came off the bench for 19 points.

NORFOLK, Va. (AP) -- Angie Bjorklund matched her career high with 29 points and hit two huge 3-pointers Thursday night as No. 11 Tennessee got back to its winning ways by prevailing in a back-and-forth battle with longtime rival Old Dominion, 81-76.

Tennessee (8-2), coming off a 73-59 loss at Texas that knocked it out of the top 10 after a record 211 consecutive weeks there, won for the 13th straight time in the series between two of the schools that first brought women's college basketball to prominence.

Old Dominion (5-3) got 17 points from Tiffany Green and 14 from Jasmine Parker, but couldn't overcome a major size deficiency as the Lady Vols outrebounded them 56-58.

Tennessee scored 23 second-chance points, and Old Dominion had just 13.

Jessica Canady's putback and Jazzmin Walters' layup gave the Lady Monarchs a 67-65 lead with 4:56 left but, just as the crowd whipped itself into an upset-minded frenzy, Bjorklund's fifth 3-pointer put the Lady Vols back in front. It was the first of her two daggers.

The second came with 1:51 to play, after Shadasia Green's putback gave the Lady Monarchs the lead at 71-70, again igniting the crowd. This time, Bjorklund connected from deep on the left wing to restore Tennessee's lead to 73-71. She added a 15-footer with 1:03 to play, pushing the Lady Vols' lead to four, and Old Dominion couldn't recover.

Alyssia Brewer added 15 points for Tennessee and Glory Johnson had 10. Vicki Baugh and Alex Fuller each grabbed 12 rebounds for the Lady Vols, who had 26 offensive boards.

Canady and Jen Nuzzo added 11 each for Old Dominion. Tennessee led 50-45 with 14:12 to play before Tiffany Green scored inside on a feed from Nuzzo, and Parker's fourth 3-pointer 36 seconds later pulled the Lady Monarchs even.

Neither team led by more than four the rest of the way.

The Lady Vols led 24-18 until Tiffany Green's two free throws with 6:39 left in the half sparked a 14-4 run for Old Dominion capped by consecutive 3-pointers by Parker.

The burst gave the Lady Monarchs a 32-28 lead, but just as quickly, Tennessee responded with an 11-4 spurt to end the half, getting two 3-pointers from Bjorklund in the run.

NORFOLK, Va. (AP) -- DeMauria Liles scored 20 points and No. 15 Maryland held Old Dominion without a field goal for the final four minutes in a 74-65 victory on Sunday.

Shadasia Green's layup gave the Lady Monarchs a 63-62 lead with 3:56 to play, but ODU, which led by as many as eight points in the first half, made just two free throws the rest of the way.

"That's not the effort that we can afford to have in our own house and expect to be a top-20 team," Old Dominion coach Wendy Larry said. "It's just not gonna happen. The rebounding differential, the free-throw differential - it's all indicative of a team that was outworked."

The Lady Monarchs (5-4), who shot 34 percent from the floor, made just nine of 14 foul shots to Maryland's 26 on 39 attempts and were outrebounded 53-43.

Old Dominion, which had its 29-game home winning streak snapped in Thursday's 81-76 loss to No. 11 Tennessee, was led by junior forward Jessica Canady's 20 points and 11 rebounds.

The back-to-back losses were the first for ODU in the 7-year-old Ted Constant Center since the 2005-06 season, when the Lady Monarchs lost 88-80 in overtime to No. 5 North Carolina on Dec. 29 and 83-67 to No. 1 Tennessee on Jan 2.

Old Dominion's first-half lead evaporated behind a 15-2 Terrapins run, and the Terps (9-2) led by two points at halftime.

ODU co-leading scorer Tiffany Green, a 6-foot-2 senior center averaging 13.8 points per game, was held without a point and picked up two fouls in the first half. She didn't score until she made a layup five minutes into the second period and finished with 10 points and 10 rebounds before fouling out with two minutes to play.

"She's a very talented player, and I thought our post players did a tremendous job in terms of defending her," Maryland coach Brenda Frese said. "Obviously it was to our advantage when she got into some early foul trouble, for us to be able to keep attacking and penetrating to the rim to be able to get the free-throw line."

Maryland guard Kristi Toliver, the ACC preseason player of the year, had 19 points, and Marissa Coleman had 16 points and 13 rebounds.
